

Student Ministry Intern



The Student Ministry Intern assists the student ministry to encourage, equip, and empower students to grow as disciples who lead others to Jesus Christ by nurturing a sense of clear Christian identity in students through teaching and serving. The internship provides individuals an opportunity to explore ministry in a professional ministry setting. The internship seeks to develop and refine skills that are necessary for effective ministry through practical experience and professional instruction, while also benefiting the Student Ministry at Hamilton Mill UMC.

Description and Responsibilities:

1. Share in the hands-on leadership of the weekly student programs as assigned by the Student Ministry Staff.
2. Lead middle school or high school group studies on Sunday mornings at 11:00.
3. Be intentional about developing relationships with students and learning names.
4. Equip and encourage students by building meaningful and deep-impacting relationships.
5. Seek to be informed about any special victories, concerns, or challenges being faced by the students &/or their families, and pass this information on to the student ministry staff.
6. Strategize regularly with the student ministry staff about any students or parents who do not seem to be connecting with other students or the ministry.
7. Pray for HMUMC students and the student ministry regularly.
8. Support the student ministry staff and volunteers in the planning & execution of all student ministry events.
9. Attend all Student Ministry events throughout the summer.
10. Serve as a greeter & host of all first-time visitors ensuring visitors are introduced to staff, volunteers and other students. Attend regular youth leader meetings for encouragement, training, and coordination.
11. Participate in reading and group study of staff selected books.
12. Participate in weekly one-on-one or group coaching sessions with Director/ Director of Middle School Ministries.
13. Live a life of Christian character that is worthy of emulation by the students.

Time Commitment: 15-20 hours per week (Sunday mornings and all special events. A weekly scheduled will be put together in conjunction with Student Ministry Staff). Two weeks during the summer will require full time participation. A list of all events will be provided prior to the start of the internship. Dates: May 20th – July 31st
